




Making a Sock Puppet

Make your own hand puppet using an old sock and recycled materials found at home.

Make

1. Put the sock on your hand to mark where the eyes and mouth will go – is it going to be an animal, monster, or person?
2. Glue or sew the eyes onto your puppet. You can insert some folded cardboard inside the sock to make a big smiley mouth. You may need help from an adult.
3. Add some hair or a nose to your puppet. Recycled wool is really great to use for hair.
4. Give your sock puppet a name. Perhaps you can make a few friends for your puppet.



Things You Need

- An old sock
- Buttons
- Wool
- Cardboard
- A sewing needle
- Glue

Anything else you think will give your puppet the most personality!

1. Gather your materials.
